



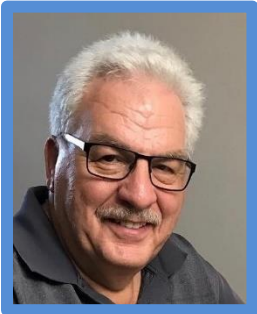

Financial Secretary's Report

As of Sept, 9 2019 Our council has 129 members.

Members Assessed Dues = 129(total)-12(inactive)-2(exempt)-17(honorary)=98

Honorary Life, Exemption and Inactive are not assessed dues. So, we have **98 members who are assessed dues.**

Dues are used by our council to pay general expenses: examples – stamps, envelopes and paper to mail out dues notices, and refreshments for members who volunteer at the bingo and degrees, as well as plaques for awards and gifts for our Kids Christmas party. At supreme level: culture of life advertising and expenses for mailing the Columbian magazine. State level expenses incurred by elected state officials to attend local council meetings; example - District Deputies.

We currently have 8 members who have not paid their assessed dues for 2019. If you are one of these reading this, hopefully, the explanation will encourage you to pay.

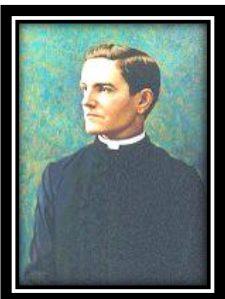

Saint Lorenzo Ruiz (1600 – 1637) Memorial September 28

Lawrence (Lorenzo) Ruiz is the first Filipino saint. He is also the first Filipino martyred for the Christian Faith. Lorenzo Ruiz was a layman, married, and had two sons and a daughter. Born in Binondo, Manila, about 1600, he was educated by Dominican friars. He served as an altar boy and later was a helper and clerk-sacristan in the church of Binondo. He was a member of the Confraternity of the Holy Rosary. He made his living as a calligrapher.

In 1636, Lorenzo was accused of murder and sought asylum among a group of Dominican priests traveling to Japan. Upon landing in Japan where Christians were being persecuted, he was arrested and imprisoned together with his companions. They underwent inhuman tortures.

On September 27, 1637, Lorenzo and the priests were taken to the "Mountain of Martyrs" where they were hung upside down in pits. After two days, Lorenzo died.

When he was offered the chance to renounce the faith to save his life, he responded, "That I will never do, because I am a Christian, and I shall die for God, and for Him I will give many thousands of lives if I had them." He and fifteen companions, martyred in the same persecution, were beatified by Pope John Paul II in Manila on February 18, 1981 and elevated to full honours of the altar by canonization on October 18, 1987 in Rome.
